



PUMPKIN GARLAND

You Will Need

- 1 Ball Of Orange Soft Craft Yarn Item: 91506
- 1 Green Chenille Stick (6mm) Item: 48970
- Jute Twine (Approx 1m) Item: 45889
- Pair Of Craft Scissors Item: 15009



Step By Step Instructions



1. Cut 1 metre piece of jute twine (this depends on how many pumpkins you are going to make and how far apart you want to space them).
2. Cut a green chenille stick into 4 even pieces.
3. Cut 4 pieces of orange yarn (approx 20 cm).

4. Wrap yarn around your four fingers until you have a nice fat wad.



5. To tie up your pumpkin slip the piece of pre-cut orange yarn between your middle fingers (inside and outside of pumpkin) and tightly tie it off. If necessary have someone tie it for you. This will be the top of your pumpkin.

6. Carefully slip the yarn ball off your fingers.



7. Plump it up to look like a pumpkin.

8. Spread the string that has tied the pumpkin off and put one piece of green chenille stick across it. Tie this down. Bend the chenille stick in half to look like leaf.



9. Once you have made all your pumpkins this is also where the jute string crosses. Lay out your string – tie the pumpkins to the string with this orange yarn and hang them by tying a loop at each end once you have finished adding your pumpkins to it.
